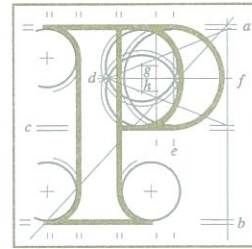

I have been asked by An Bord Pleanála to refer to the above-mentioned application.

In order to assist the Board in keeping a record of your application in spatial data format, I would be grateful if you could provide the 'red line boundary' of the site, as shown on the Site Location Map submitted to the Board on 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2017, as an ESRI shapefile in the Irish Transverse Mercator (ITM IRENET95) co-ordinate reference system, for use in Geographical Information Software. The ESRI shapefile should be named **JA0040** and have the following fields;

Shape	Geometry	Polygon	A closed polygon representing the site boundary. The polygon should not self-intersect or overlap.
GIS_REF	Text	JA0040	The An Bord Pleanála Reference Number e.g. JA0040.
